- Proactively acquire new stores, pickers, and collection partners, expanding Reclaim's collection network.
- Track and analyze collection data to identify high-performing routes and opportunities for growth.

- Oversee daily operations of the hub including collection, sorting, baling, and storage.
- Ensure all materials meet Reclaim's quality and quantity standards.
- Optimize logistics, scheduling, and resource allocation to minimize downtime and maximize throughput.

- Supervise daily cash and stock reconciliation between field teams, operators, and finance.
- Maintain accurate hub records for all purchases, payments, and stock movements.
- Coordinate with the Finance and Purchases teams to ensure timely reporting and compliance with company policies.

- Recruit, train, and supervise hub staff—including 3-wheel riders, baler operators, and casual laborers.

- Build and maintain strong relationships with local vendors, store owners, and community partners.
